

Ipswich Academies celebrate impressive gains in attainment

Huge academic progress has been made in the last year at two Ipswich Primary Schools, Piper's Vale Primary Academy and Murrayfield Primary Academy.

Piper's Vale Primary Academy achieved above average expected progress at the end of Reception, in phonics in Year One and reading and maths in Year 6. Year Six pupils achieved national average in writing and above average for maths.

Murrayfield Primary Academy's has achieved the best overall attainment results in the school's history. Year Six SATS saw 63% of the pupils achieve the national standard in reading, writing and maths combined, with 80% of pupils achieving the national standard in mathematics and an excellent 87% in writing.

Piper's Vale Primary Academy is a primary school for 420 pupils aged between four and 11 years, along with a nursery for pupils from three years upwards. It is led by principal Kimberley Morton, who was appointed to the post in April this year, following a year as interim principal.

Murrayfield Primary Academy has 60 children per year group, as well as a 26-place nursery. Principal Neil Winn has led the school for several years, overseeing a
