<u>Catch-up Programme for Men ACWY & Diptheria, Tetanus and Polio</u> Year 10's – Academic Year 2020/21

Following the school closures due to Covid-19, we would like to catch up this year's year 10's outstanding vaccinations in the Summer Term 2021, as advised by NHS England.

The MenACWY vaccine helps protect older teenagers and young adults from getting <u>meningitis</u> (inflammation of the lining of the brain) and <u>septicaemia</u> (blood poisoning). Tetanus, Diphtheria and Polio are serious diseases that can affect the nervous system, breathing and heart.

If you do not submit a consent form, we will contact you in order to confirm that you do not wish your child to receive the vaccine.
